








AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 96106 OF CHAPTER 96, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THE AVAILABILITY OF AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS IN ALL GOVERNMENT OF GUAM OFFICES BY JUNE 30, 2024.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new §96106 of Chapter 96, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *added* to read:

“§ 96106. Requiring the Availability of Automated External Defibrillators in All Government Offices.

(a) Each Department and Agency of the Government of Guam, inclusive of autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies which has an office that provides a service to the general community of Guam shall provide access to an automated external defibrillator AED. The AED shall be available during hours that the government offices are open to the public. Each Department or Agency may create the

1 provisions for the deployment and use of AEDs to include, but not be
2 limited to, the following:

3 (1) the locations and quantities in their facilities of
4 AEDs,

5 (2) the training requirements for staff and volunteers to
6 use the AEDs,

7 (3) Monitoring AEDs to ensure the devices will
8 function correctly as needed, and

9 (4) Security and protection of the AEDs from theft,
10 criminal mischief (vandalism) and damage or destruction from
11 acts of nature.

12 (b) Access to AEDs, as required by paragraph (a), supra, must
13 be completed by June 30, 2024.”

14 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

15 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
16 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
17 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
18 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
19 Act are severable.
