**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §6225(c) TITLE 4, GUAM CODE  
ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING MAYORS  
COUNCIL PERSONNEL HAZARDOUS PAY DURING  
EMERGENCIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** Subsection (c) of §6225 of Title 4, Guam Code Annotated is  
3 hereby *amended* to read:

4 “(c) (1) Notwithstanding § 6304 of Article 3, Chapter 6, Title 4,  
5 Guam Code Annotated, the Civil Service Commission  
6 Hazardous/Environmental Pay Policy and Procedures, or any other  
7 provision of law, rule, regulation, and Executive Order, and for the  
8 purposes of this Act, Hazardous duty positions shall be identified as  
9 follows:

10 (A) all sworn Officers of the Guam Airport Police;

11 (B) all sworn Conservation Officers of the Division of Aquatic  
12 and Wildlife Resources of the Department of Agriculture;

13 (C) all sworn Guam Park Patrol Officers of the Department of  
14 Parks and Recreation;

15 (D) those employed by the Department of Youth Affairs, or  
16 who are assigned to the Department of Youth Affairs, and who are

1 engaged in juvenile detention and rehabilitation work at the  
2 Department of Youth Affairs;

3 (F) those employed by the Office of the Attorney General  
4 whom he or she specifically designates; ~~and~~

5 (G) all sworn Officers of the Guam Fire Department; and

6 (H) those employed and specifically identified by the Mayors  
7 Council of Guam as hazardous duty personnel, upon exposure to  
8 dangerous conditions in preparation and following typhoons and  
9 during period of declaration of emergency.

10 (2) The appointing authorities of the Antonio B. Won Pat  
11 International Airport Authority, Guam the Department of Agriculture, the  
12 Department of Parks and Recreation, the Department of Youth Affairs, the  
13 Office of the Attorney General, the Guam Fire Department, and the  
14 Department of Administration shall identify the direct exposure personnel,  
15 and upon exposure, shall be entitled to the ten percent (10%) hazardous pay  
16 differential.”  
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
