## AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW ARTICLE 10 TO CHAPTER 51A OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE ORDOT DUMP RESERVE FUND.

1	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
2	Section 1.
3	A new Article 10 is hereby added to Chapter 51A of Title 10, Guam Code

7	§ 51A1001. Title and Purpose.

1	§ 51A1001. Title and Purpose. This Act shall be known as the "Ordot Dump
2	Reserve Fund Act." The purpose of this Act is to create a reserve fund for the post-
3	closure maintenance of the Ordot Dump.
4	<u>§ 51A1002. Ordot Dump Reserve Fund.</u>
5	(a) There is hereby created the Ordot Dump Reserve Fund (Fund), which shall
6	be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the government
7	of Guam, including the General Fund. The Fund shall be a continuing fund,
8	and amounts credited to the Fund shall not be subject to further
9	appropriation, and monies remaining in the Fund at the end of a fiscal year
10	shall not be transferred to the General Fund. The Fund shall not be subject
11	to the transfer authority of I Maga'hågan Guåhan.
12	(b) The Fund shall include all money, payments, or other things of value in the
13	nature of civil damages or other payments received by the Treasurer of
14	Guam relating to the Partial Consent Decree approved by the U.S. District
15	Court for the District of Columbia on September 25, 2023, in Government
16	of Guam v. United States of America, Case No. 1:17-cv-2487. The Fund
17	shall also include any interest earned on such amounts.
18	(c) The Treasurer of Guam shall promptly credit all money, payments, or other
19	things of value received pursuant to the Partial Consent Decree identified
20	in subsection (b) to the Fund.
21	(d) The Guam Solid Waste Authority shall administer the Fund.
22	<u>§ 51A1003. Eligible Expenditures.</u>
23	Monies in the Fund shall be expended exclusively for costs associated
24	with the implementation of the Ordot Dump Post-Closure Care and Maintenance
25	Plan submitted by the Guam Solid Waste Authority pursuant to the Consent Decree
26	approved by the U.S. District Court for Guam on February 11, 2004, in United States
27	of America v. Government of Guam, Civil Case No. 02-00022.

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## § 51A1004. Reporting Requirements.

Annually, no later than October 31, the Guam Solid Waste Authority shall
submit a report on the activity, revenue, and expenditures to and from the Fund to *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. The report shall
also be posted on the Guam Solid Waste Authority website. The report shall include,
but not be limited to:
(a) the revenue credited to the Fund;

- 8 (b) the expenditures attributable to costs of administering the Fund,
- 9 <u>including administrative support to the Guam Solid Waste Authority; and</u>
- 10 (c) <u>an itemized list of expenditures.</u>"

11 Section 2. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or 12 circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect 13 other provisions or application of this Act which can be given effect without the 14 invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are 15 severable.
