**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §§ 3104, 3105, 3110; AND *ADD* A
NEW § 3102.1(g) CHAPTER 3, TITLE 3, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED; AND TO *ADD* A NEW § 3101.3(g)
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO EXTENDING THE TERM OF
APPOINTMENT OF A REGISTRATION CLERK AND
THE TIMES OF REGISTRATION.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 3104 of Chapter 3, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated (Times of
3 Registration) is *amended* to read as follows:

4 **“§ 3104. Times of Registration.**

5 ~~Ten (10)~~ Twenty-one (21) days prior to any election, the registration
6 polls shall be closed, and no further affidavits of registration shall be accepted
7 by the Commission.”

8 **Section 2.** § 3105 of Chapter 3, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated (Place of
9 Registration) is *amended* to read as follows:

10 **“§3104. Place of Registration.**

11 The registration of electors shall be in progress at all times at the
12 main office of the commission during such hours as the office is open for
13 business until the closing of the registration rolls. Electors may also be

1 registered at such times and places within Guam as the Commission shall
2 deem advisable and convenient from the time registration is open until ~~ten~~
3 (40) twenty-one (21) days prior to an election.”

4 **Section 3.** § 3110 of Chapter 3, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated is *amended*
5 to read as follows:

6 “§ 3110. Qualifications of Registration Clerks; Term of
7 Appointment.

8 Any elector appointed as a registration clerk shall serve a limited term,
9 which shall begin from the date of appointment until midnight on the day that
10 is ~~twenty-one (21)~~ forty-five (45) days before the next scheduled general
11 election. The Commission shall promulgate policies and procedures to carry
12 out the intent of this Section. The Commission may also establish other terms
13 of appointment, consistent with the intent of this Section, for special elections,
14 plebiscites, initiatives and any other non-general elections as they deem
15 necessary to allow for voter registration to be conducted by duly appointed
16 registration clerks.”

17 **Section 4.** A new § 3102.1(g) is hereby *added* to Chapter 3, Title 3, Guam
18 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

19 “(g) Electors may be registered electronically in accordance with this
20 Section from the time registration is open until twenty-one (21) days prior to
21 an election.”

22 **Section 5.** A new to § 3101.3(h) is hereby *added* to Chapter 3, Title 16
23 Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *added* to read as follows:

24 “(h) Electors may be registered in accordance with this Section from
25 the time registration is open until twenty-one (21) days prior to an election.”

26 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective immediately upon
27 enactment.

1 **Section 7. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application
2 to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such
3 invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be
4 given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the
5 provisions of this Act are severable.
