AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 8108(7) OF DIVISION 1, CHAPTER 8, TITLE 11, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO LAWFUL OPERATION OF CANNABIS-RELATED FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Lihelsatura Guahan* finds
that under the authority granted by 11 G.C.A. § 8110 of the Guam Cannabis
Industry Act, the Guam Cannabis Board promulgated rules regarding the need
for cannabis testing. *See* Article 7 of the Cannabis Control Board's Rules and
Regulations.

I Lihelsatura finds that the requirements for a Cannabis Testing Facility, as
defined m 11 G.C.A. § 8102(1), while laudable, could stop Guam's cannabis
industry before it sta1is.

I Lihelsatura further finds that currently there are no Cannabis Testing
 Facility companies on island that can or will meet the requirement that it is ISO
 17025 accredited or certified by the Americans for Safe Access Patient
 Focused Certification Program but there are several companies attempting to
 establish a cannabis business.

I Lihelsatura finds that requiring a Cannabis Testing Facility where none
 exists will further delay and derail Guam's cannabis industry.

1 *I Lihelsatura* further finds that some testing is not only beneficial but 2 needed.

Through this Act, *I Lihelsatura Guahan* intent to exempt cannabis businesses from some of the testing requirement while there is no Cannabis Testing Facility on island.

6 Section 2. A new § 8108 (7) is hereby *added* to Chapter 8, Division 1, Title
7 11, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

- **§ 8108.** Lawful Operation of Cannabis-Related Facilities. 8 delivering. distributing. or selling cannabis. to 9 (7)consumers or other cannabis businesses *if and only* if there is no 10 Cannabis Testing Facility on Guam, that it is ISO 17025 accredited 11 or certified by the Americans for Safe Access Patient Focused 12 Certification Program. so long as the cannabis (flower only) is 13 marked with a label indicating the potency of the cannabis that 14 includes the total amount of cannabinoid content including 15 tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and other phytocannabinoids such 16 cannabidiol (CBD), cannabigerol (CBG) 17 and as tetrahydrocannabivarin (THCV). 18 (i) Upon the licensure and opening of a Cannabis 19 Testing Facility by Guam Cannabis Commission. all 20 cannabis must be tested as required by the applicable rules 21 and regulations. The Cannabis Commission shall notify 22 every licensee that it has ten days to demonstrate that it is 23 compliant with the relevant testing requirements. The 24 company's Responsible Official is responsible for 25 demonstrating compliance. 26
- 27 Section 3. Effective Date. This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
