AN ACT TO *APPROPRIATE* NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$900,000) FROM SECTION 30 REVENUES FOR THE PHYSICIAN RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION EDUCATION DEBT REPAYMENT PROGRAM.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guahan finds that 2 3 \$74,245,153 was projected as Section 30 revenue available for appropriation in the Governor's Fiscal Year 2025 Executive Budget Request submitted to the Guam 4 Legislature on January 31, 2024. I Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that the 5 government of Guam may receive additional revenue in Section 30 funds for Fiscal 6 Year 2025 totaling approximately \$80,000,000. It is the intent of I Liheslaturan 7 Guahan to prioritize the use of any additional Section 30 Funds received during 8 9 Fiscal Year 2025 to public safety, health and education.

10 Section 2. Appropriation for the Physician Recruitment and Retention 11 Education Debt Repayment Program. Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars 12 (\$900,000) is appropriated from Section 30 revenues to the Physician Education 13 Debt Repayment Fund for the Physician Recruitment and Retention Education Debt 14 Repayment Program pursuant to Chapter 52 of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated for 15 Fiscal Year 2025. This appropriation shall remain available until fully expended.
