AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$900,000) FROM SECTION 30 REVENUES FOR NURSING RECRUITMENT AND RETENTION INCENTIVES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that \$74,245,153 was projected as Section 30 revenue available for appropriation in the
- 4 Governor's Fiscal Year 2025 Executive Budget Request submitted to the Guam
- 5 Legislature on January 31, 2024. I Liheslaturan Guahan further finds that the
- 6 government of Guam may receive additional revenue in Section 30 funds for Fiscal
- 7 Year 2025 totaling approximately \$80,000,000. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan*
- 8 Guahan to prioritize the use of any additional Section 30 Funds received during
- 9 Fiscal Year 2025 to public safety, health and education.
- Section 2. Appropriation for the Nursing Recruitment and Retention
- 11 Incentives. Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$900,000) is appropriated from
- 12 Section 30 Funds to the Department of Administration for the Nursing Recruitment
- and Retention Incentives pursuant to 4GCA § 6229.1 for Fiscal Year 2025. This
