AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIFTEEN MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED TWENTY-EIGHT THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,828,000) FROM FISCAL YEAR 2024 GENERAL FUND REVENUES COLLECTED IN EXCESS OF THE ADOPTED LEVELS ENUMERATED IN PUBLIC LAW 37-42, AS AMENDED, TO THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY FOR A THREE (3)-MONTH EXTENSION TO THE PRUGRÅMAN AYUDA PARA I TAOTAO-TA ENERGY CREDIT PROGRAM, RELATIVE TO PROVIDING CUSTOMERS WITH THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300) CREDIT TOWARD THEIR ACCOUNT.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Appropriation.**

3 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Fifteen
4 Million Eight Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$15,828,000) is
5 hereby appropriated from Fiscal Year 2024 General Fund revenues collected
6 in excess of the adopted levels enumerated in Public Law 37-42, as amended,
7 to the Guam Power Authority for a three (3)-month extension to the
8 *Prugrãman Ayuda Para I Taotao-ta* Energy Credit Program which was
9 established by Public Law 36-106.

1 (b) The *Prugrâman Ayuda Para I Taotao-ta* Energy Credit Program is
2 to provide each of the Guam Power Authority’s fifty-two thousand seven
3 hundred sixty-two (52,762) residential, master-metered, and commercial
4 customers with Three Hundred Dollars (\$300) credit toward their account, to
5 be disbursed One Hundred Dollars (\$100) each month for the months of July
6 2024, August 2024, and September 2024, and shall only be credited to the
7 current billing of such months. The sum of Fifteen Million Eight Hundred
8 Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$15,828,000) shall be disbursed to the Guam
9 Power Authority in three (3) equal monthly installments for the purposes of
10 this Section. The Guam Power Authority shall reflect the One Hundred
11 Dollars (\$100) energy credit on each customer’s billing statement pursuant to
12 this Section. The Department of Administration shall equally disburse this
13 appropriation to the Guam Power Authority for each of the three (3) months
14 of July 2024, August 2024, and September 2024.

15 (c) Validation of Master-Metered Accounts. The Guam Power
16 Authority shall, from all Master-Metered Accountholders, obtain a notarized
17 list of the number of active residential utility power sub-accounts under that
18 Master Meter to ensure the proper application of the credit to the Master-
19 Metered Account.

20 (d) Credits received from *the Prugrâman Ayuda Para I Taotao-ta*
21 Energy Credit Program shall be tax-exempt.

22 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
