AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 4401(g), OF ARTICLE 4, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4, AND § 43104(a) OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 43, DIVISION 4, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO GUAM CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSIONERS' COMPENSATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 4401(g) of Article 4, Chapter 4, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

“§ 4401. Civil Service Commission.

(g) Civil Service Commissioners, shall, without limitation, each receive ~~Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)~~ Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for every meeting attended to adjudicate appeals, complaints, grievances or other disputes, or to perform rule”

Section 2. § 43104(a) of Article 1, Chapter 43, Division 4, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

“§ 43104. Uniform Compensation for Boards and Commissions.

(a) A member of a board or commission shall be compensated in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for attending a board or commission meeting, such compensation not to exceed One-Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month. Civil Service Commissioners shall, without limitation, each receive ~~Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)~~ Two Hundred Dollars (\$200) for every meeting attended to adjudicate appeals,

1 complaints, grievances or other disputes, or to perform rulemaking
2 functions as provided in statute, rule or regulation.”

3 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

4 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provisions of this Act or its application to
5 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall
6 not affect any other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
7 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 Act are severable.
