**AN ACT TO *AMEND* PUBLIC LAW 37-125 TO INCREASE REVENUE PROJECTIONS BY TEN MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$10,800,000) AND APPROPRIATE SAID REVENUE TO THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY FOR TWO (2) MONTHS EXTENSION TO THE *PRUGRÅMAN AYUDA PARA I TAOTAO-TA* ENERGY CREDIT PROGRAM, PROVIDING CUSTOMERS WITH TWO HUNDRED DOLLAR (\$200) CREDIT TOWARD THEIR ACCOUNT.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.**

The Legislature finds that rising costs and inflation have increased the financial strain on the people of Guam. To provide immediate relief, the *Prugrãman Ayuda Para i Taotao-Ta* Energy Credit Program was established, providing a \$100 monthly power credit. The Legislature further finds that extending this program through November 2024 will help alleviate financial burdens for Guam residents.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to amends Public Law 37-125 to increase revenue projections and appropriate the additional revenue to the Guam Power Authority for the sole purpose to fund the extension of Energy Credit Program.

**Section 2. *Public Law 37-125* is hereby *amended* to read.**

**Revenue Adjustment**

The revenue projections under Public Law 37-125 shall be increased by Ten Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$10,800,000) for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.

**Section 3. Appropriation to the Guam Power Authority.**

From the increased revenue in Subsection 1, Ten Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$10,800,000) is hereby appropriated to the Guam Power Authority. This appropriation shall fund the continuation of the *Prugrãman Ayuda Para i Taotao-Ta* Energy Credit Program, providing a

1 (\$200) power credit for eligible residential accounts for the months of October and November  
2 2024.

3 **Section 4. Effective Date:** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

4 **Section 5. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the application thereof  
5 to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect any other provision  
6 or application of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application,  
7 and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
