AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TEN **MILLION DOLLARS (\$10,00,000) FROM THE GENERAL** FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION **RELATIVE TO PROTECTING THE JOBS OF PRIVATE** SECTOR **EMPLOYEES** WHILE THE TOURISM INDUSTRY REBOUNDS BY EXTENDING THE **BENEFITS OF THE LOCAL EMPLOYERS' ASSISTANCE PROGRAM** (LEAP) AS INITIALLY FUNDED BY PUBLIC LAW 36-65.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Appropriation.

The sum of Ten Million Doilars (\$10,000,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration to extend the benefits of the Local Employers' Assistance Program (LEAP) as initially funded by Public Law 36-65. The General Fund sources available to fund said appropriation, *supra*, are any unappropriated surpluses from Fiscal Years 2021, 2022 or the first quarter of Fiscal Year 2023.

9 Section 2. Administration.

Funds appropriated by Section 1 of this Act are not subject to any transfer authority. Small Business shall be given priority for grants funded pursuant to Section 1 of this Act. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, regulation or executive order, the Director of Administration and the Guam Economic Development Authority are authorized to extend the benefits of the LEAP program until the funds appropriated are expended. The Guam Economic Development Authority shall provide reports on its website, on a monthly basis until the funds are expended, for the awards provided pursuant to this Act.
