









AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 51101(b)(12) AND *AMEND* §51102(a)(3) ALL OF CHAPTER 51, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO ADDING THE DIRECTOR OF PARKS AND RECREATION AND THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE AND TAXATION CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIONS SUPERVISOR AS VOTING MEMBERS OF THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING (POST) COMMISSION AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new Subparagraph (12) is *added* to § 51101(b) of Chapter 51,
3 Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

4 “(12) The Revenue and Taxation Criminal Investigations Supervisor
5 and Tax Investigators at the Department of Revenue and Taxation.”

6 **Section 2.** § 51102(a)(3) of Chapter 52, Title 17 Guam Code Annotated, is
7 *amended* to read as follows:

1 “(3) The Commission shall be composed of ~~fifteen (15)~~ seventeen
2 (17) members as follows:

3 (A) the Chief of ~~the Guam Police Department~~, or his
4 designated representative;

5 (B) the Chief of the Guam Airport Police, or his designated
6 representative

7 (C) the Chief of the Guam Port Police, or his designated
8 representative;

9 (D) the Attorney General, or his designated representative;

10 (E) the Director of ~~the Customs and Quarantine Agency~~, or his
11 designated representative;

12 (F) the Director of ~~the Department of Corrections~~, or his
13 designated representative;

14 (G) the Chief of the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife
15 Resources of the Department of Agriculture, or his designated
16 representative;

17 (H) one (1) non-voting representative from the University of
18 Guam (UOG), appointed by the President;

19 (I) one (1) non-voting representative from the Guam
20 Community College (GCC), appointed by the President;

21 (J) the Chief Marshal of the Unified Guam Judiciary, or his
22 designated representative;

23 (K) the Fire Chief of ~~the Guam Fire Department~~, or his
24 designated representative;

25 (L) the Chief of Probation of the Unified Judiciary, or his
26 designated representative;

1 (M) one (1) voting representative from the Department of
2 Administration, the Personnel Services Division Administrator,
3 appointed by the Director of Administration;

4 (N) the Director of ~~the Department of~~ Youth Affairs, or his
5 designated representative; ~~and~~

6 (O) the Chief of the Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Unit, or
7 his designated representative,

8 (P) the Director of Parks and Recreation, and

9 (Q) The Revenue and Taxation Criminal Investigations
10 Supervisor.”
