AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (c) TO § 92111 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 92, TITLE 9 OF GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO REQUIRING THOSE CONVICTED OF VEHICULAR HOMICIDE WHILE IMPAIRED TO SUPPORT THE SURVIVING MINOR CHILDREN OF THE VICTIM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Subsection (c) of § 92111 of Article 1, Chapter 92, Title 9 of Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *added* to read:

“(c) In addition to the sentencing requirements in Subsection (b) of this Section, any person who is convicted of vehicular homicide while driving impaired, as defined in this Section, shall be required to support the victim's surviving minor children, if any, until each child reaches the age of eighteen, or until the age of twenty-three for any child who enrolls full-time in a college, university, vocational school, or trade school, in an amount to be determined by the court and to be paid to the person responsible for raising the children.”
