## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. A new Subsection (c) of § 92111 of Article 1, Chapter 92, Title 9
- 3 of Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *added* to read:
- 4 "(c) In addition to the sentencing requirements in Subsection (b) of this
- 5 Section, any person who is convicted of vehicular homicide while driving impaired,
- 6 as defined in this Section, shall be required to support the victim's surviving minor
- 7 children, if any, until each child reaches the age of eighteen, or until the age of
- 8 twenty-three for any child who enrolls full-time in a college, university, vocational
- 9 school, or trade school, in an amount to be determined by the court and to be paid to
- the person responsible for raising the children."
