AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW CHAPTER 55 OF DIVISION 5, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO MANDATING ALL GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS TO BE ADA COMPLIANT, AND TO CITE THIS ACT THE "GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOLS ADA COMPLIANCE ACT OF 2023."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM: 1 2 **Section 1.** A new Chapter 55 is *added* to Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, to hereby read as follows: 3 4 "Chapter 55 5 **Guam Public Schools ADA Compliance Act of 2023** 6 **§ 55101. Short Title.** This Act shall be known as the "Guam Public" 7 Schools ADA Compliance Act of 2023." Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds 8 § 55102. 9 that accessibility is a fundamental right for all individuals, including students with 10 disabilities, in order to ensure equal access to educational opportunities. I 11 Liheslatura further finds that most public schools in Guam are not compliant with the accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and its 12 13 amendments, resulting in barriers to access and inclusion for students with 14 disabilities.

1	The purpose of this Act is to establish a comprehensive framework to ensure
2	that all public schools in Guam are fully compliant with the accessibility
3	requirements of the ADA, and to promote inclusive and accessible educational
4	environments for all students.
5	§ 55103. Definitions.
6	As used in this Chapter:
7	(a) ADA means the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, as
8	amended.
9	(b) Public Schools means all public schools in Guam, including
10	primary, middle, and high schools.
11	§ 55104. Implementation of ADA Compliance Plan.
12	(a) Within 180 days of the enactment of this Act, the Guam
13	Department of Education (DOE) shall develop and implement a
14	comprehensive plan to ensure that all public schools in Guam are fully
15	compliant with the accessibility requirements of the ADA. The plan shall
16	include, but not be limited to, the following:
17	(1) A thorough accessibility audit of all public schools in
18	Guam, conducted by qualified accessibility experts to identify areas of
19	non-compliance.
20	(2) A timeline for addressing identified areas of non-
21	compliance, including prioritization based on severity and urgency.
22	(3) Detailed specifications for modifications and
23	improvements necessary to achieve ADA compliance, including
24	architectural modifications, installation of accessibility features and
25	equipment, and training for school staff on ADA requirements and
26	disability awareness.

1 (4) A plan for ongoing monitoring and reporting on progress towards ADA compliance, including regular progress updates to the 2 3 Guam Legislature and the public. (5) A plan for ensuring that any new construction or 4 5 renovation of public schools in Guam shall comply with the 6 accessibility requirements of the ADA and other applicable federal and 7 local accessibility standards. 8 The DOE shall allocate adequate financial resources to 9 implement the ADA compliance plan, which may include seeking federal 10 grants, partnerships with local or federal agencies, American Rescue Plan 11 funds, and other funding sources. Accessibility Training and Education. 12 § 55105. 13 The DOE shall provide regular training and education for all (a) school staff, including teachers, administrators, and support staff, on ADA 14 15 requirements, disability awareness, and best practices for promoting inclusive and accessible educational environments. 16 17 The DOE shall collaborate with disability advocacy (b) organizations and experts in the field of accessibility to develop and 18 19 implement training programs for school staff, as well as educational materials 20 and resources for students and parents on disability awareness and inclusion. 21 **§ 55106.** Reporting and Accountability. 22 The DOE shall provide regular progress reports to the Guam (a) 23 Legislature and the public on the implementation of the ADA compliance

plan, including updates on the status of accessibility audits, modifications and

improvements made, and progress towards achieving full ADA compliance in

all public schools in Guam."
