



**AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE
EXTENSION OF CONCESSION AGREEMENTS OF THE
ANTONIO B. WON PAT INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT
AUTHORITY, GUAM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that given the damage and uncertainty caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, Typhoon
4 Mawar, and other geopolitical issues and hardships that have arisen over the past
5 several years, it is projected to take at least several years for Guam's visitor industry
6 and for the A.B. Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam (GIAA) to achieve

1 the enplanement trajectory and financial stability, through the restoration of
2 operating reserves and capital improvement funds, expected prior to the COVID-19
3 pandemic. Accordingly, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the current GIAA
4 concessions are in the best interest of the GIAA and Guam; and that an extension of
5 such concessions is in the best interest of GIAA and the island.

6 **Section 2. Authority to Extend Concession Agreements.** The A.B. Won
7 Pat International Airport Authority, Guam is authorized to negotiate extensions of
8 its concession agreements for up to an additional three (3) years from the end of the
9 then-current term upon terms and conditions in the best interests of GIAA, subject
10 to approval by the GIAA Board of Directors.

11 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

12 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
13 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
14 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
16 severable.
