3 **WHEREAS,** it is the sense of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to recognize the life and
4 accomplishments of those distinguished citizens of this great island, and it is the custom
5 of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to commend those public servants who have devoted
6 themselves faithfully serving in the best interests of this community and the needs of its
7 residents; and

8 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Thomas “Pete” P. C. Daga graduated from South Western
9 University located in Cebu City, Philippines in 1979; and

10 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Thomas “Pete” P. C. Daga’s career at the A.B. Won Pat
11 International Airport Authority began on May 6, 1981, when he was hired as a Security
12 Officer; and

13 **WHEREAS,** Mr. Thomas “Pete” P. C. Daga has dedicated his time and efforts
14 to helping the people of Guam through the completion of training such as One-Hundred
15 Twenty (120) Hour Airport Security Forces training, Civil Aviation Security Seminar,

1 Twenty-Four (24) Hour Doppler Radar Operator training, Dealing with the Public
2 training, Introduction to Emergency Management Course training, Polytesting
3 Screening and Identification Training Program, Security Identification Display Area -
4 SIDA training, the Tenth (10th) Annual Tourism Safety/Security Conference, the Basic
5 Airport Security Coordinator and Law Enforcement School, the Communication Skills
6 for Internal and External Customer Service training; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Pete” P. C. Daga was recognized throughout the
8 years for his distinguished service and commitment to the people of Guam and has
9 earned awards including the Employee of the Quarter award, the Five (5) Years of
10 Service award, the Ten (10) Years of Service award, the Governor’s Certificate of
11 Commendation award, the Fifteen (15) Years of Service award, Manager of the Year
12 award, the Twenty (20) Years of Service award, the Twenty-Five (25) Years of Service
13 award, the Guam International Airport Authority (GIAA) Commendation award, the
14 Governor’s MAGPRO Supervisor of the Year Nomination, the Thirty (30) Years of
15 Service award, GIAA Distinguished Service Ribbon award, the Thirty-Five (35) Years
16 Service award, and the Forty (40) Years of Service award; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Thomas “Pete” P. C. Daga’s commitment to public service
18 extends above and beyond as is evident through his extensive service, his work ethic,
19 and his unwavering dedication. Throughout the years, Mr. “Pete” P. C. Daga showcased
20 unwavering commitment and considerable skill which enabled him to serve on multiple
21 detail appointments for the Assistant Chief of Airport Police and the Chief of Airport
22 Police and to become a Guard, Airport Security Guard I, Airport Security Supervisor,
23 and Airport Police Supervisor during his career with the A. B. Won Pat International
24 Airport Authority; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on April 14, 2023, Mr. Thomas “Pete” P. C. Daga retired from an
2 outstanding career with the Government of Guam and the A.B. Won Pat International
3 Airport Authority after Forty-One (41) of faithful service; now therefore, be it
