1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI SIETTE NA LIHESLATURAN GUĀHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the Pacific Regional Hawai'i Drill Competition (PACRIM) is a
4 military drill competition conducted by the *Nā Mea 'Ike 'Ia's* (NMII) Royal Hawaiian
5 Guard (RHG) program that traces its roots in the *Kanaka 'Ōiwi*-Native Hawaiian
6 martial art of *Lua*, spiritual art of *Hula*, and the drill and ceremony traditions of the
7 Hawaiian Royal Guards established by the Hawaiian Kingdom Monarchs King
8 Kamehameha I in 1810 and King David Kalākaua in 1874; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the PACRIM competition is comprised of military-style drills
10 based on the four disciplines of drill: Regulation, Exhibition, Color Guard, and
11 Inspection, and the competition events are Color Guard, Armed/Unarmed Regulation
12 Drill, Unarmed Inspection, Armed/Unarmed Exhibition Team/Platoon Flight,
13 Armed/Unarmed Exhibition Duet Drill, and Armed Exhibition Solo Drill; and

1 **WHEREAS**, on April 13th, 2024, the PACRIM competition was held in
2 Hawai'i's McKinley High School, and the event hosted JROTC units from throughout
3 the Pacific region including units from Guam, Samoa, and Hawai'i; and

4 **WHEREAS**, for the April 13th, 2024 PACRIM competition, the Guam Southern
5 High School sent its JROTC unit to participate in the events to represent our island and
6 our region in the Pacific and to showcase the drill skills of our island's youth; and

7 **WHEREAS**, due to the excellent leadership skills and guidance taught by
8 coaches LTC Carl Q. Cruz and SFC Juan T. King, the Southern High School JROTC
9 Color Guard Rifle Team and Unarmed Drill Team won 1st Place in the Color Guard
10 competition and the Exhibition Drill competition respectively, bringing immense pride
11 to our island and inspiring our JROTC units to do the same; and

12 **WHEREAS**, next to the excellent coaches LTC Carl Q. Cruz and SFC Juan T.
13 King; the Southern High School cadets that participated in the April 13th, 2024
14 PACRIM event are Thomas R. Calimlim, Jude D. Cruz, Lisa Herbert, Victor Martinez
15 Sayama, and William Mesa in the Color Guard Rifle Team, and Kalena Agustin, Nobert
16 Castro, Sharlie Cervantes, Tori Cummings, Alyssa-Marie E. Duran, Essence Gonzales,
17 Eirian Gonzales, Laela Herbert, Taliah Mansapit, Chiara Ortega, Kiani Paulino, Piuse
18 L. Reyes, and Kadryn Sanchez in the Unarmed Drill Team; now therefore be it

19 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee of Rules of *I Mina'trentai Siette Na*
20 *LiheSlaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I LiheSlaturan Guåhan* and the people
21 of Guam, recognize the Southern High School JROTC cadets for participating in the
