The Bureau requests that Bill No. 101-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 101-37 (COR) is an act to *repeal and reenact* § 1310 of Article 1, Chapter 1, Title 22 Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations, relative to adopting updated emission standards for sulfur oxides from fuel combustion to ensure the island of Guam meets the national ambient air quality standards for sulfur dioxide transmitted by the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA).

Based on comments received from the GEPA regarding Bill No. 101-37 (COR), there is no financial impact in regards to the passage of this amendment. As per 10 GCA Chapter 49 Section 49119, no other diesel imported into Guam may be above the Ultra Low Sulfur diesel standard as prescribed by USEPA regulations. This amendment will align Guam law with the Federal standard.
