The Bureau requests that Bill No. 102-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 102-37 (COR) is an act to add a new Article 2 to Chapter 2, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to mandating biannual reporting requirements by agencies of the Government of Guam to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on the hiring of unclassified positions and why it was impracticable to appoint such positions in the classified service pursuant to the merit system.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
