Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 105-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 105-37 (LS) is an act to add a § 4124 (b) (3) of Chapter 4, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to allowing school and village beautification as student service-learning hours.

The intent is to promote student involvement within their community and environment by having 10 hours dedicated to village/island beautification and 10 hours dedicated to school campus beautification of the required 75 hours of Service-Learning Hours for high school graduation.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill from the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) on May 2, 2023 and a follow-up request on May 9, 2023. The Bureau has not received any official comments from GDOE as of the date of this waiver request.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
