*Hafa Adai!* Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 109-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 109-37 (LS) is an act to add a new § 4124(b)(3) and (4) to Chapter 4 of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to providing parity by creating an exemption from completing the full 75 hours of service learning requirement for graduating high school student in School Year 2023-2024 and instead require the completion of 35 hours of service learning and for graduating high school students in School Year 2024-2025 and instead require the completion of 55 hours of service learning.

The intent is to provide parity by creating an exemption for all graduating high school students for the School Year 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 from completing the full 75 hours of service learning and who were excluded from the effects of Public Law 36-96.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill from the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) on May 4, 2023 and a follow-up request on May 9, 2023. The Bureau has not received any official comments from GDOE as of the date of this waiver request.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
