The Bureau requests that Bill No. 117-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 117-37 (COR) is an act to amend § 3102.1 of Chapter 3, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the duties of the Guam Education Board (GEB).

The intent is to reorganize the GEB from being responsible for all policies that govern the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) to having general supervision over the GDOE.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill from the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) on May 16, 2023. The Bureau has not received any official comments from GDOE as of the date of this waiver request.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
