The Bureau requests that Bill No. 148-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 148-37 is an act to amend Article 1 of Chapter 34, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated and repealing relative to updating laws surrounding the control and licensing of pets. The Bill updates terminology in the current law in regards to microchip tags issued for pets as well as revises term lengths for particular violations in Chapter 34, Title 10, GCA.
