Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 149-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 149-37 (COR) is an act to add a new § 1221, Division 4, Chapter 12, of Title 2, Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations, relative to the adoption of rules and regulations providing temporary expedited procurement protest procedures for acquisitions funded with the American Rescue Plan Act, Education Stabilization Fund, or Head Start Grant Moneys allotted to the Guam Department of Education (GDOE).

It should be noted that the preamble of Bill 149-37 is in error and that it is an act to add a new § 12217 instead of a new § 1221. The intent is to adopt the rules and regulations submitted by the Public Auditor pursuant to Public Law 37-6 for the temporary expedited procurement protest procedures for acquisitions funded with the above noted fund sources allotted to the GDOE.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill from the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) on July 11, 2023. The Bureau has not received any official comments from GDOE as of the date of this waiver request.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
