The Bureau requests that Bill No. 151-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 151-37 (COR) is an act to add a new Chapter 54C to Division 2, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, relative to prohibiting the production and use of Nuclear Energy on Guam. The intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* is to prohibit nuclear derived energy in the island of Guam.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill No. 151-37 (COR) from Guam Environmental Protection Agency on 7/24/2023 and 7/25/2023 and have not received any official comments as of the date of this fiscal note waiver.
