The Bureau requests that Bill No. 166-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 166-37 (COR) is an act to add a new §§ (e) to §8103 of Chapter 8, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated relative to requiring boards and commissions audio files to be posted to the respective agency's website.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
