Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 170-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 170-37 (COR) is an act to add a §79607 to Article 6 of Chapter 79, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, relative to authorizing the Independent Vietnam Veterans Association of Guam to use a portion of the Skinner Plaza, Lot 5 and Lot 6, to establish a Vietnam Veterans Memorial monument honoring the seventy-seven (77) sons of Guam who made the ultimate sacrifice and all Vietnam Veterans in the service of your island and county. The monument will occupy no more than twenty feet (20') in length and twenty feet (20') in width of the Skinner Plaza. Although there is an opportunity cost that will be lost by the Government of Guam (GovGuam) opting to utilize the plot of land for a memorial instead of pursuing economic opportunities, the GovGuam will not be liable for any expenses related to the construction of the monument.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
