The Bureau requests that Bill No. 189-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 189-37 (COR) is an Act to add a new §5014 to Subarticle A of Article 1, and, to repeal §5217 of Subarticle B of Article 3, all of Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Government of Guam's procurement policy in favor of individuals with disabilities.

The proposed legislation details qualifications for being a non-profit corporation employing individuals with disabilities, or a business concern owned by an individual or individuals with disabilities. Further, the proposed legislation stipulates that procurement for any supply or service that is offered by such non-profit corporation shall be awarded to that non-profit corporation if the supply or service is available within the period required by the procuring entity and the price for the supply or service does not exceed one hundred five percent (105%) of the lowest bidder.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
