The Bureau requests that Bill No. 192-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 192-37 (COR) is an Act to add a new Article 15 to Chapter 5, Division 1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contracts for all Government of Guam agencies.

The proposed legislation defines IDIQ contracts and identifies applicable uses of IDIQ contracts.
