Hafa adai, Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 199-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 199-37 (LS) is an act to *amend* § 23101 and add a new § 23110 of Chapter 23, Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated relative to sugary drinks. The amendment contained in the proposed legislation is relative to defining the types of sugary drinks covered under this legislation and defining self-service at eating and drinking establishments. Further, this proposed legislation intends to add a new §23110, which places limitations on the maximum size of drink portions (17 fl. oz.) that may be sold at food service/ eating and drinking establishments; however, it does not apply to sugary drinks sold for medical purposes and bottle drinks sold for carry-out.

As such, this bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
