The Bureau requests that Bill No. 211-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 211-37 (COR) is an act to add a new § 3223 to Article 2, Chapter 3, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to prioritizing access to federal financial assistance through the completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) by Guam public high school seniors. This would require the parent or guardian of each student or, if a student is at least eighteen (18) years of age, as a prerequisite to receiving a high school diploma from a public high school including a charter school partially or fully funded by the Government of Guam, to complete and submit the aforementioned FAFSA document.

Based on the forgoing, the proposed Bill is administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact FY2024 Government of Guam appropriations.
