The Bureau requests that Bill No. 233-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 233-37 (LS) is an act to amend § 17116 and repeal § 17118, Chapter 17, Title 3, Guam Code Annotated, relative to changing preliminary reports to quarterly reports and eliminating final and supplementary reports. These amendments, if adopted, would only affect political candidates, political parties and/or committee and not the Government of Guam.

Based on the forgoing, the proposed Bill is administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact FY2024 Government of Guam appropriations.
