Hafa Adai Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests the Bill No. 237-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 237-37 (COR) is an act to amend §5150 of Subarticle F, Article 2, Chapter 5, Division 1, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, relative to updating the duties of the Attorney General by increasing the threshold for procurement oversight and advisement to One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) or more.

Based on comments received from the Office of Attorney General (OAG) regarding Bill No. 237-37 (COR), the proposed change to Section 5150 would be beneficial to both the OAG and the various government agencies but should not result in an increase in cost. As such, the referenced Bill does not ascertain any immediate fiscal impact upon the revenues or the expenditure of any funds of the Government of Guam.
