Hafa adai, Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 242-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 242-37 (COR) is an act to *amend* §§ 21101, 21102, 21104, 21107, and 21115 all of Chapter 21, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated relative to Sanitary Permit Requirements. The amendment contained in the proposed legislation is relative to defining the types of facilities and regulations covered under this legislation. Additionally, the proposed legislation amends § 21104 to allow the Director or designee to inspect an establishment or activity at a frequency based upon an adopted policy while §21106 is amended to allow the designee to issue notices when an establishment has one (1) or more demerits. Further, §21115 of the proposed legislation is amended to mandate that the Director of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) notifies the Department of Revenue and Taxation of the name and location of a business whose ABC license has been revoked or suspended.

As such, this bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
