The Bureau requests that Bill No. 243-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 243-37 (COR) is an act to *add* a new §11318 to Article 3, Chapter 11, Title 7, Guam Code Annotated, relative to removing the statute of limitations for financial and property exploitation of an elderly person or individual with disability.

Based on comments received regarding Bill No. 243-37 (COR), the Judiciary of Guam (JOG) believes that absent further information in the bill, the approximate fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time.

As such, the bill is administrative in nature and poses no immediate fiscal impact upon any of the funds of Government of Guam.
