The Bureau requests that Bill No. 248-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 248-37 (COR) is an Act to amend §5214(b) of Subarticle B of Article 3, Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated relative to the sole source procurement of technology hardware, software, maintenance, support and customization services.

The proposed legislation identifies the qualifications for sole source procurement of technology hardware, software, maintenance, support and customization services and establishes the authorized term of a sole source contract should it be awarded.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
