The Bureau requests that Bill No. 263-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 263-37 (COR) is an act to transfer Lot No. 3458-R1, Chalan Pago-Ordot, Guam from the Department of Parks and Recreation to the Office of the Chalan Pago-Ordot Mayor.

Guam Public Law 18-15, granted management of the parcel (and facilities) to the CPO Mayor's Office for minor repairs and maintenance through the allocation of the Community Development Fund (Host Community Fund), which is annually appropriated to the MCOG. Correspondence with the Mayors' Council of Guam indicates that there are no financial impacts to the agency pursuant to Bill 263-37 (COR). Thus, the proposed legislation is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
