The Bureau requests that Bill No. 278-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 278-37 is an act to add a new § 90.16.2 to Article 1, Chapter 90, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated relative to complaints filed against correction officers. The Bill also provides that any correction officer or department employee who fails to forward the information or fails to make reports required by the proposed legislation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed legislation from the Department of Corrections (DOC) on April 26, 2024 and has not received any official comments from the DOC as of the date of this waiver request.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of the Government of Guam.
