Hafa Adai Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 297-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 297-37 (COR) is an Act to add a new subsection (mm) to Article 1, Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated and to amend §61304(b)(7), §61309(b), and §61310, of Article 3, Chapter 61, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated relative to zoning.

In relation to Rural zones, the proposed legislation establishes the definition of a Biological Extractive Industry and amends the conditional use of rural zones to include Biological Extractive Industry (in lieu of the current conditional use of Extractive Industry). In relation to Light Industrial zones, the proposed legislation adds the conditional use of mining or quarrying that maintains functionality of the property to be consistent with features that support residential or commercial future uses other than a mine or quarry. In relation to Heavy Industrial zones, the proposed legislation adds the conditional use of mining or quarrying.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
