Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 311-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 311-37 (COR) is an act to amend § 2103.12 of Chapter 2, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, relative to ensuring transparency in appointments to Acting Directors and Acting Deputy Directors positions through mandatory notification.

The subject Legislation would require notification of the aforementioned appointments or details to such positions to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guahan*, the Attorney General of Guam, and the Office of Public Accountability. Such notifications shall be sent within twenty-four (24) hours of the appointment date and shall include the appointed individual's name, the start date of their acting tenure, and the anticipated duration of their appointment.

Based on the forgoing, the proposed Bill is administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact FY2024 Government of Guam appropriations.
