Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 317-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 317-37 (COR) is an act to authorize the operation of Guam Public Schools that are awaiting inspection for School Year 2024-2025.

According to comments received from the Superintendent of the Guam Department of Education (GDOE), the fiscal impact of the Bill 317-37 (COR) is negligible and that the GDOE have already programed funds to do the preparation for inspections and inspection fees in their current FY2024 Budget and FY2025 Budget Request. The Superintendent further noted that the impact will occur when GDOE will have to close schools as it will impact the Department of Public Works for buses and increase operational costs on all buildings that are still open as well as increase costs for digital hotspot leases.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of the Government of Guam.
