The Bureau requests that Bill No. 323-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 323-37 (COR) is an act to enhance transparency and accountability in the Guam Legislature by ensuring that travel authorizations are accessible to the public through the mandatory posting of details concerning the purpose and expenses of all official travels by members of the Guam Legislature on its official website. According to comments received from the Executive Director of the 37th Guam Legislature, there is no additional cost to implement this Bill as Travel Authorizations and Reports by members of the Guam Legislature are already posted on the official website of the 37th Guam Legislature.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
