Hafa Adai! Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 332-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 332-37 (COR) is an act to amend § 8601(i)(2), § 8602(a), (b), and (d), and § 8603(a) and (b) of Article 6, Chapter 8, Title 12 of the Guam Code Annotated, to include the authorization of hosting photovoltaic and battery energy storage systems on land and not solely on qualified rooftops under the Virtual Power Plant Program (VPPP). Further, the amendments intend to include 501(c)3 non-profit organizations registered to do business on Guam as a developer under the VPPP, instead of only licensed solar development businesses owned and operated by a legal resident of Guam.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
