The Bureau requests that Bill No. 334-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill 334-37 (LS) is an Act to add a new §75A.126 to Article 1, Chapter 75A, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated relative to removing legal clouds on the existing leases issued by the Chamoru Land Trust Commission (CLTC).

The proposed legislation defines the framework for CLTC to conduct its review of existing leases and provides corresponding actions the CLTC shall make based on the determination of such review. The proposed legislation provides a deadline of December 31, 2027 for CLTC to complete its review of existing leases.

As such, the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
