The Bureau requests that Bill No. 335-37 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 335-37 (LS) is an act to authorize a temporary increase in the Guam Department of Education's (GDOE) emergency procurement authority limit to One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per school to address health and safety issues until September 30, 2025.

It should be noted that the Bureau has sought input on the proposed legislation from the GDOE on August 9, 2024 and had sent a follow-up request on August 13, 2024. The Bureau has not received any official comments from the GDOE as of the date of this waiver request.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
