*Hafa Adai!* Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 336-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 336-37 is an act to amend section 8108(a)(7) of Division 1, Chapter 8, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated relative to the lawful operation of cannabis-related facilities. The amendments include the addition of disclaimers stating (A) "the marijuana contained within this package has not been tested for contaminants" prior to the licensure of a Cannabis Testing Facility by the Cannabis Control Board and (B) a disclaimer warning of the addictive nature of marijuana use and its impairing of an individual's ability to drive a motor vehicle or operate heavy machinery as well as the health risks associated with marijuana including cancer, tachycardia, hypertension, heart attack, and lung infection. The disclaimer further adds the warning to keep out of the reach of children. The Bill additionally makes specific revisions to the language of the existing law.

Absent comment from the Department of Revenue and Taxation (DRT), the Bureau finds that the Bill, as currently written, is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
