*Hafa Adai!* Senator Barnett:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 339-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 339-37 (COR) intends to amend § 715(l)(13) of Chapter 7, Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated to exempt the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) from the requirement to provide one hundred eighty (180) days or its equivalent of nine hundred (900) instructional hours for the school year 2024-2025. This is subsequent to the delay in the opening of Guam public schools for the new school year as a result of the GDOE and Guam Department of Public Health and Social Services being unable to complete their inspections as mandated by Public Law 37-4.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
