The Bureau requests that Bill No. 351-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 351-37 (COR) is an act to add a new Section 7.11 to 9 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 7 relative to exception for criminal liability regardless of juvenile status, and to amend Section 5106 of 19 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 5 relative to the jurisdiction of the Superior Court of Guam as provided for in Section 7.11 of 9 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 7.

It should be noted that the Bureau had sought input on the proposed Bill No. 351-37 (COR) from the Judiciary of Guam on 09/09/2024 and have not received any official comments as of the date of this fiscal note waiver request. However, the Bill is determined to be administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
