The Bureau requests that Bill No. 362-37 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 362-37 (COR) is an act to add a new subsection 5215.1 to Subarticle B, Article 3 of Chapter 5, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Special Crisis Procurement Authority for the Guam Fire Department (GFD) to meet the minimum compliance standard stipulated by rule 1710 of the National Fire Protection Association (standard for the organization and deployment of fire suppression operations, emergency medical operations, and special operations to the public by career fire departments). According to comments received from the GFD, the proposed legislation's intent is to expedite the procurement process during times of critical need. GFD does not anticipate any fiscal impact as a result of this proposed legislation as funds for such procurement needs are already contained within its approved budget for the fiscal year.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
